Each of the **Gold Key Leadership Awards** has specific activities to complete. Refer to each brochure for the required activities. The Third Step **Gold Key Leadership Award** requires attaching the certificates received upon completion of the e-learning courses with this form when submitting. Be sure to include these certificates.

You have three years to complete each of the individual **Gold Key Leadership Awards**. After completing the **First Step Gold Key Leadership Award** and submitting to Ohio PTA, start completing the activities for the **Second Gold Key Leadership Award**. Again you have three years to complete the **Second Step Gold Key Leadership Award**. Once completed and submitted to Ohio PTA, start working on the **Third Step Gold Key Leadership Award**. Upon completion of each Gold Key Leadership Award the PTA member will receive a pin (1st Step) or charm (2nd & 3rd Step) and certificates.
